The Ship

Clipper Stad Amsterdam sails worldwide as a passenger vessel under Dutch flag. She is an authentic, full rigged ship. The vessel has a tonnage of 723 GT and carries up to 2200m² of sail. She has 14 luxury passenger cabins and a spacious long room for dinners and presentations. The Clipper Stad Amsterdam is available for business events, luxury cruises and adventurous journeys for individuals. The crew consists of 30 enthusiastic professional sailors from 10-12 nationalities. The common language on board is English.

The 1st Officer is:

- second in command and must be able to replace the captain under all circumstances
- responsible for all aspects of safety and environmental aspects on board of the ship
- watch-officer from 04:00 – 08:00 and 16:00 – 20:00 at sea and in turns officer on duty in port
- responsible for the administration of the ships certificates
- in cooperation with the shore office responsible for the preparation of port calls
- responsible for customs and immigration formalities
- human resources representative on board in close cooperation with the shore office.
 - responsible for mustering of seafarers and checking of validation of certificates
 - monitoring the training-needs of the crew and responsible for the vessel's safe manning
 - responsible for the evaluations and assessments of the nautical crewmembers
 - ARBO- coordinator on board
 - the medical officer
 - responsible for medical assistance of passengers and seafarers
 - responsible for the inventory of the ship's hospital and medicines
 - together with the 2nd officer responsible for the ICT-equipment on board

- Experience as officer on a traditional square-rigged Tallship (min. 3-4 years)
- Valid CoC Chief Mate <3000gt or unlimited (II/2) or preferably Master (II/2)
(*Not necessarily sailing-vessels*)
- Valid STCW certificates: Basic Safety, Advanced Firefighting, Proficiency in survival craft and rescue boats, Medical Care, Ship's Management; Designated Security Duties (or SSO), GMDSS, Radar Navigator Mgmt.; Crowd Management; Crisis Management and Human Behavior, Ecdis Generic.
- Valid seaman's book and medical certificate worldwide
- Good administration and organizational skills, ability to prioritize
- Strong decision making, coaching and team building skills
- Able to deal with stressful circumstances at all weather conditions
- Proficient in Office Word and Excel, ICT affinity
